Spanning two floors of a six-story administration building from the 1990s, this streamlined and subtly futuristic project offers an entirely new office concept for the software giant SAP. According to client requirements, the office presents a tailor-made concept that endorses teamwork and supports the specific processes of software development. Bright uplifting spaces replace the previously uncommunicative and insulating cell structure. The new configuration improves morale and creativity as employees perform their daily tasks, enriching independent and collaborative working processes and encouraging open communication.

From game lounges to meeting rooms and breakout think tanks, the office layout ensures a broad diversity of work typologies to keep employees

motivated and engaged. The team-oriented business environment responds to the specific requirements of programmers while calling for further cooperation, facilitated by an all-hand meeting room for up to 200 staff, seminar space, a library, and a cafeteria. Glass conference rooms with vibrant curtains allow the meeting cubes to open up fully or shut tightly according to the nature of the discussion taking place inside. Culminating in filleted edges, recessed lighting, and angled surfaces, the workspace mixes a forward-thinking spatial agenda with high-end finishes and detailing, promoting an office environment that stimulates the imagination of its employees.
